The twelfth annual meeting of the **Society for Environmental Law and Economics** will be held on Monday and Tuesday, June 22 & 23, 2020, at the Department of Land Economy and Selwyn College -University of Cambridge, UK. We hope to build upon the great success of past meetings, and continue to build a community of environmental scholars interested in working in the intersection of law, economics, and environmental or natural resource issues. We welcome both theoretical and empirical papers, as well as studies looking at problems at local, state, national, and international levels.

In the spirit of collegiality, the meeting will use a workshop format in which all sessions are plenary. Please note that **all** participants are expected to attend **all** of the presentations. Our goal is to create a program that includes a variety of disciplinary perspectives, ideally consisting of 20-25 papers over the two-day period. This year, we may include some "lightning round" sessions with shorter presentations.

No funding will be available for travel or lodging expenses. Food and drink will be provided during the workshop and a dinner will be hosted on Monday evening for the speakers.
